And stop looking westward and sending Russian sons and daughters to their deaths on the Ukrainian front. Stop clinging to power, because eventually you will lose it. No, you cannot have everything you want, because you do not take good care of what you already have, and that is very, very much and very, very beautiful. You live in a beautiful country with warm-hearted people and great cultural treasures. Do not plunge them into misfortune. Do not rule over them, but live with them in peace. Shame on you!

To all dictators and oppressors everywhere who have disappeared from our news because there is no more room among the garbage we ourselves produce: Stop destroying our world! Shame on you!

People of all these nations, do not allow yourselves to be imprisoned and kept down any longer. Have hope, gather yourselves, and fight back! Enough is enough!

We have had enough of the people in Germany who insult the left-wing green electorate and the German government as warmongers and claim to be the only ones who want peace. That is wrong! We also want peace, and we want it now! But we will not allow the law of the strongest, the law of those who are becoming richer and richer, to spread across this earth like a new pandemic. The degree of civilisation of a society is measured by how it treats its weakest members, its minorities, and the fragility and delicacy of all. We are happy to live in one of the freest and safest countries on earth; we are grateful for our health and social systems; we are grateful that we are in this particular place on planet Earth and not in the global south, which, thanks to our industrial boom based on coal and fossil fuels, is now too hot and inhospitable to live in. However, the fact that we live here is not our right, but merely our good fortune. We are grateful to be able to travel freely, to express our opinions, and to be taught that individual freedom always has to do with the freedom of our counterparts. We are grateful that we can surf the internet, which allows us to look out into the world and form our own opinions, if only we try. We are grateful for 80 years of peace, that Germany was liberated from Hitler's dictatorship by the intervention of the Allies. We are grateful that the Jewish people are trying to forgive us for the infinite suffering that our ancestors inflicted on them, which is actually unimaginable. That is why we have been failing for too long to speak clearly when it might be appropriate to do so, and we must do betterand we must do so immediately! Because

Germany has a responsibility in the world. Taking responsibility for its actions or history is something quite different from "cultivating guilt". Yes, and we can really do better in this regard. We have this responsibility, and we must accept it. Because of our own history, because of our democracy, which on the whole functions well, because of the work of many who ensured that this country is one to which people want to flee if they have to, a country that is looked up to and listened to in the world, no matter how small it may be.
